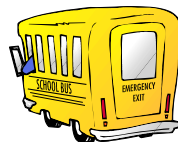

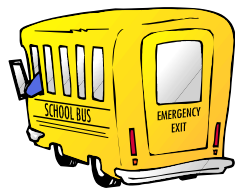

Term-time Out of School Clubs

The Breakfast and After School Clubs are provided as an added service to you and your children. In order to facilitate your working hours we aim to offer a safe and relaxed environment for your child to spend their time.



Bright n' Early Club

We will be open from 7:30am and will greet the children into our main nursery building, before going to our dedicated club for a leisurely breakfast of cereals and/or toast and fruit, which is served between 8.00-8.15am. All children will then be able to play with selected toys and games appropriate for their age before departing to school between 8:30-8:45am.

The children will then be delivered to the school premises and their safe entry is ensured.

Bright Lights Club

The children will be collected from their individual schools according to the finishing time of the school. Once they arrive back to the premises they will be able to spend time relaxing and unwinding from the days events with a period of Outside Play when possible. After our Snack Tea around 4.00pm the children will then be allowed to choose their activities from the large range that will be available each day including art & craft, board games and computer access. We are happy to oversee Homework where the child is able to undertake this on their own. We also have a range of indoor sports equipment for use by the children.

Children can be collected at anytime up to 6:00pm to suit your needs.

Bright Breaks Holiday Clubs

Bright Breaks may just be the break you are looking for to provide your child with a warm, safe, stimulating and creative environment during the school holidays.

Parents can be confident in leaving their children in the safe hands of this now established club which is run alongside the existing nursery care using the same philosophies of learning through play in a stimulating environment.

Activities are planned to meet both developmental and individual needs of the child and include arts & crafts, sport, music, stories, reading, physical play and organised trips out. Children will also have the opportunity to improve their computer competence on our PC.

How to Book
